

Notice of Various Frauds

Deutsche Bank has become aware of following frauds:

- An investment fraud that is using the Deutsche Bank name in different formats and targeting potential investors resident in Ireland. The website is promoting Fixed Rate Bonds and Investments that require the visitor to provide their name, email address and contact number to receive details of the fake Deutsche Bank investment opportunity. A fake Deutsche Bank Investment Prospectus is sent out using a fake domain name such as info@dbmarketing.irish instead of the legitimate Deutsche Bank domain @db.com. The telephone number **+353 1 960 9633** included in the email is also fake and is not the number for our Head Office in Dublin.
- A similar fraud operates in the same way as the fraud outlined above. In this case, those perpetrating the fraud are issuing a fake Prospectus entitled: "Fixed Term Deposit Bond Prospectus 2023". Those perpetrating this fraud are also using the fake website of www.db-ireland.com. In addition, they are using a fake email address advisor@db.Irish and fake telephone phone number **+353 1 254 8404**.
- We are aware of an investment manager offering Deutsche Bank Bonds (10% interest rate over a 1-year fixed term), to potential investors resident in Ireland. Please note that Deutsche Bank is not offering bonds to Irish consumers at this or other rates.

A common theme in all cases is Irish residents looking online for better interest rates and investment opportunities. These are specific frauds of which Deutsche Bank is aware. They may be replicated using slightly different details to those outlined above.

It should be noted that Deutsche Bank is not offering any banking or other regulated services to Irish resident retail consumers. Furthermore, there is no connection whatsoever between Deutsche Bank AG Dublin Branch and the various fraudulent firms referenced in these Prospectuses.

- We have also been informed of several cases of frauds by individuals posing as employees or foreign entities of Deutsche Bank. Please note, for example, that no Irish entity of Deutsche Bank offers products or services on French territory.

The above investment frauds target individuals which often result in financial losses for the affected individual. **Note that Deutsche Bank will never ask a client to transfer their monies related to any investment to a third-party account.**

Please:

- ✓ Be aware that such frauds are not legitimate and are often linked to a criminal enterprise, such as a fraud.
- ✓ Consider making a criminal complaint to the relevant authorities if you believe that you may have suffered financial harm including a financial loss in relation to this matter.
- ✓ Validate communication purporting to be from Deutsche Bank or relating to an investment opportunity provided by Deutsche Bank, by contacting Deutsche Bank Ireland directly using our official contact details.
